Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Preform welding activities with minimum instructions and supervision
- Ability to judge the type and gauge of steel to be welded, making proper heat adjustments as required.
- Subject completed welding tasks to appropriate inspections.
- Utilize material handling equipment in conjunction with welding tasks.
- Maintain required production records for jigs, fixtures and machines.
- Perform minor maintenance on equipment.
- Assume responsibility and care of assigned tools and equipment.
- Observe and practice safety procedures and policies.

- Welds components in flat vertical or overhead positions.
- Ignites torches or starts power supplies and strikes arcs by touching electrodes to metals being welded, completing electrical circuits.
- Clamps, holds, tack-welds, heat-bends, grinds or bolts component parts to obtain required configurations and positions for welding.
- Operates manual or semi-automatic welding equipment to fuse metal segments, using processes such as gas tungsten arc, gas metal arc and flux-cored arc, plasma arc and shielded metal arc, resistance welding and submerged arc welding.
- Other duties as assigned.
- Welding all types of steels and alloys
- Heavy plate welding 1/4" to 12" thick personal hand tools required
